Who is this course for?

Applicants to study general medicine in English.

What is the success rate of course graduates?

More than 90 percent of the graduates not only pass the entrance exam but also successfully complete the first year of study at university, which is considered the most challenging year.

What is the difference between COMPLEX and FAST?

The courses differ primarily in the initial knowledge of the English language and the intensity of study.

For the COMPLEX programme, we require at least B1 level. The course starts in September and you will receive a student visa for 12 months.

Number of lessons: 1225

For the FAST programme, you must present a certificate of English proficiency of at least B2 level. The course starts in November and you will receive a student visa for 10 months (valid until 31 August next year).

Number of lessons: 675

Will I have to take an entrance exam after the Foundation?

Yes. After completing the course, you will take part in the medical school admission process.

How do I do the nostrification?

Nostrification is the process of recognition of foreign education. If you don't have it yet, the course will help you with it.

Are there any other fees?

Everything related to the course is already included in the price, you will not have to pay any extra fees.

How do I get my residence permit?

Studying in the course requires a long-term stay for the purpose of study. You will receive a residence permit for 12 months for the COMPLEX course and 10 months for the FAST course.

If you are not in the Czech Republic, we will go through the visa process with you and we will give you consultations throughout the whole procedure.

If you are already in the Czech Republic on a student visa, you can extend your stay on the basis of our course. Upon successful enrolment, we will provide you with the necessary information about extending your residence permit.

What are the options of accommodation during the course?
